The National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS), the largest Board in open schooling, has declared its Sr.Secondary April 2010 examination result on 09<sup>th</sup> June 2010. About 2 lakh students appeared in this exam. The result at a glance is as under:

43.65% of female candidates students were declared certified as against 39.92% of male candidates. Over all pass percent in Sr. Secondary Examination is 41.05% which is about 5 percent higher than the last year's (April/May 2009 examination) pass percentage of 36.02%.

The pass percent among the SC candidates is 38.20%, among ST candidates 38.84% and among OBC candidates 38.53%. In addition to this, 33.79% of Ex-servicemen and 36.54% of the handicapped candidates were declared successful and certified.

Among the 12 Regions of NIOS the best performing Regions are Hyderabad Region with 71.79%, Patna Region with 59.19% and Allahabad Region with 55.37%. The percentage of candidates certified in Delhi Region is 37.54%.

Out of 1952 candidates appeared from overseas examination centres, 39.34% were declared successful and certified.

The Mark Statements, Migration Certificates and Provisional Certificates are being dispatched to the study centres. The students may collect their Mark Statements, Migration Certificate and Provisional Certificate from their respective study centres (AIs) after 8-10 days. The examination fees for the October 2010 examination will be deposited as per schedule from 16<sup>th</sup> June to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2010 through online mode or at respective study centre(AI)/Regional Centre.

The result of Secondary Examination will be declared on 10<sup>th</sup> June 2010 at 11.00AM

## Re-evaluation of Answer Scripts Introduced by NIOS

The National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) has introduced the **re-evaluation of answer scripts** at the Senior Secondary level from the current (April-May 2010) examination. This will be in addition to the already existing system of scrutiny/re-totaling of marks for Secondary and Senior Secondary levels.

Candidates who have appeared for the Senior Secondary examination of NIOS in April-May 2010 can apply for re-evaluation of answer scripts in theory paper of any subject. There is no provision for re-evaluation in Practical Papers.

Candidates can apply for re-evaluation for one or more subjects through a single application. No second request for re-evaluation will be entertained. The application for re-evaluation should be sent by registered post/speed post only to the concerned Regional Centre.

The processing fee for re-evaluation is Rs. 500/- per subject to be submitted through bank draft drawn in favour of Secretary, NIOS payable at the city of the concerned Regional Centre.

Candidates must apply for re-evaluation in their own handwriting within 15 days from the date of declaration of results on the NIOS website [www.nios.ac.in](http://www.nios.ac.in). Incomplete applications and those received after the due date will not be entertained and will summarily be rejected without any notice.

The communication regarding the re-evaluation result shall be sent to the candidate within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of application. It will also be posted on the NIOS website.

**There is no re-evaluation in the Secondary Examinations.**

The National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS), the largest Board in open schooling, has declared its Secondary April 2010 Examination result on 10<sup>th</sup> June 2010. About 2 lakhs students appeared in this exam. The result at a glance is as under:

45.77% of female candidates were declared certified as against 43.45% of male candidates. Over all pass percent in Secondary Examination is 44.16% which is about 7 percent higher than the last year's pass percentage of 37.08%.

The pass percent among the SC candidates is 41.55% , among ST candidates 42.81% and among OBC candidates 43.64%. 36.33% of Ex-servicemen and 40.97% of the handicapped candidates were declared successful and certified.

Among the 12 Regions of NIOS the best performing Regions are Hyderabad Region with 70.56%, Patna Region with 67.57% and Allahabad Region with 53.81%. The percentage of candidates certified in Delhi Region is 38.77%.

Out of 1094 candidates appeared from overseas examination centres, 55.66% were declared successful and certified.

The Mark Statements, Migration Certificates and Provisional Certificates are being dispatched to the study centres. The students may collect their Mark Statements, Migration Certificate and Provisional Certificate from their respective study centres (AIs) after 8-10 days. The examination fees for the October 2010 examination will be deposited as per schedule from 16<sup>th</sup> June to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2010 through online mode or at respective study centre(AI)/Regional Centre.

Candidates not satisfied with their results may apply for Scrutiny of Marks/Rechecking of results within 30 days of declaration of results on the web site. They may apply to the concerned Regional Centre with a fee of Rs.200/- per subject.

NIOS had declared its Senior Secondary results on 9<sup>th</sup> June 2010, in which about 41% candidates were declared successful. For Senior Secondary candidates, reevaluation has been introduced in addition to existing scrutiny/rechecking.
